- The winners of the \$1200 award for each category will be announced before August 31st, 2025.

Essay Details:

Choose one topic to write about:

- How to help restore legal protection for the unborn in Canada.
- Why should abortion be illegal in Canada?
- Why is assisted suicide (MAiD) morally wrong?

Grading (each worth 25%):

- Is the thesis stated clearly and is well-supported throughout?
- Is the information well-organized? Does it flow from one idea to the next?
- Is the grammar, spelling, sentence structure, and punctuation of a high standard?
- Are the ideas clearly presented and are they backed with logic and facts. Is the essay impactful and persuasive?

What a woman Julie was!

Throughout her 101 years of life, Julie had a heart for the weakest and most defenseless among us. She gave her time, energy, and resources to numerous causes in Kelowna and elsewhere.

Notably, she managed the Pro-Life Thrift Shop on Sutherland Avenue for an amazing 36 years without ever taking a dime in compensation, all for a whole class of human beings whose very personhood today's culture refuses to acknowledge: pre-born babies.

Julie's dedication to the pro-life cause was profound, deep, and unwavering. It was a big part of who she was and she inspired many people to stand up and speak out for the voiceless, defenseless child in the womb.

Pro-Life and More:

Julie also contributed to *Inn from the Cold*, *Freedom's Door Recovery Centre*, *Society of Vincent de Paul*, *The Salvation Army*, *Share*, and many others who serve the less fortunate in our community.

She established the French Cultural Centre in the 1960's, co-founded the Kelowna Right to Life Society and the Seaton Centre for Seniors, and served on the Catholic Women's League council, to name but a few of her contributions to the community.
